Congratulations are also in order for Stacy Huber who won the gift-filled Christmas Tree sponsored by our Moose Legion Activities Committee.

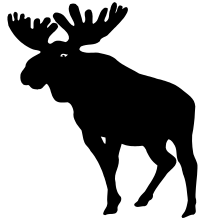
