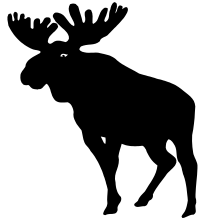
Our Lodge & Fraternity Has A Special Opportunity For Those Who Risk Their Lives To Protect Us...Our First Responders!!!!
