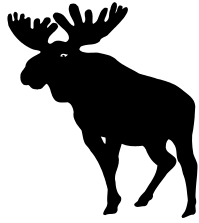

Moose General Laws...page 92...Section 48.8 state:

“Participation in Social Quarters of any Lodge is a privilege and not a right of membership. This privilege is conditioned upon all persons conducting themselves, while in and about any social quarters or during activities sponsored by the Lodge or House Committee, in a gentlemanly/ladylike and orderly manner. Any person who fails to comply with this law shall be denied the privilege of the Social Quarters at the discretion of the House Committee which includes ALL social activities sponsored by the Lodge.”
