

Mooseheart Report August 2020

While we are still processing so many sudden changes and uncertainty in the shadow of COVID-19, please know that Mooseheart continues to serve as a haven for children in need. Residential homes are open and providing a safe and healthy home for our children. There have been no cases of Covid -19 at Mooseheart. Thank you for your on-going commitment to the children. During this time, they are continuing to process applications for admission to Mooseheart .

There were seven fifth graders that were promoted to sixth grade and 14 eighth graders that moved on to high school. They will have a promotion ceremony on the first day of school. Four of the eighth graders are from Pennsylvania home.

The Mooseheart Graduating class of 2020 had eight girls and eleven boys for a total of 19. The majority of them will be going on to college. On August 01, 2020 they were able to come back on campus to walk across the stage and receive their diplomas.

As of this writing, there are 100 children on campus. Twenty more will return by the middle of September. There are 25 children on the waiting list to get into Mooseheart.

School starts this week with between 70 or 80 attending class with approximately 25 students doing distant learning.

A tree was planted on the grounds of the Pennsylvania home in memory of our Pilgrim brother, Donald Sartor, along with a plaque honoring him. Many of us attended his memorial service at Tunkhannock Moose Lodge on August 8th.
